SEAFORTH NETBALL CLUB GRADING DAYS

All players 10 years and over (ie turning 10 this year) must be assessed on court and graded within Seaforth Netball Club by the Club Grading Committee.

Club grading is **compulsory** for all players and will be held at John Fisher Park, Curl Curl, as follows:

Saturday 6 th February	2.30-5.30pm 2.30-4.30pm	*10 year olds (ie turning 10 in 2010) 11 year olds
Sunday 7th February	2.00-3.00pm 3.00-4.30pm 3.00-5.00pm 4.30-5.30pm	14 and 15 year olds (tbc - check website) 13 year olds 12 year olds Nettas**
Monday 8th February	4.00-6.00pm	*10 year olds

***NB: Tuesday 9th February 4.00-6.00pm**

Wet weather alternative for 10 year olds & 11 year olds if needed

- * **10 year olds** will be required to attend on both Saturday and Monday as this is the most difficult age group to grade, with players coming from many different, previously ungraded Netta teams. In the case of wet weather, players will need to attend a grading session on Tuesday 9th February. Please try and wear the same T shirt/top on both days for easier identification.

Please note: Grading may mean that friends may not be able to play together.

- ** We also require **Netta players** (players turning 8 or 9 in 2010) to attend Grading Day, not to be graded, but to formalise teams. We try to keep friends together as much as possible. Please note that teams must consist of players with the same birth year (a Manly Warringah Netball Association requirement).

MWNA GRADING ROUND ROBIN (For 10 year olds only – ie turning 10 in 2010)

All players in the 10 years teams **must** attend this Round Robin, which is to be held on **Sunday 21st March 2010** at John Fisher Park, Curl Curl, starting at 8.30am and going for most of the day. Players are to wear their Seaforth uniforms.

Parents: please ensure the players have plenty to drink and eat, as well as sunscreen, sun visor or hat and/or wet weather gear, as this day can be very long and hot.

To help girls with their first year of umpiring, all 12 years or older players who are new to the Club (or netball) are required along with one coach/manager from 12 year teams.

SEAFORTH DEVELOPMENT DAY (8 & 9yr Nettas, 10s, 11s, 12s & 13s) - Sunday 7th March, Curl Curl

This is for all players to attend. As 12 year old players will be required to umpire this year, there will be plenty of umpiring practice for them and 13 yr players. It is also an opportunity for all players, especially new players and new teams, to have a game. This will be held at John Fisher Park, Curl Curl, 3.00-5.00pm. Uniform is optional.

COACHES:

We'd love to hear from any parent or player from 14 years old interested in coaching or assisting coaching. Any girls doing their Duke of Edinburgh award can do their community hours coaching a netball team. We offer full support, training courses and ongoing assistance. MWNA are holding a "Welcome to Coaching Course", Saturday 20th March at Curl Curl to assist any new coaches (or past coaches looking for a refresher). MANAGERS:

Every junior team must have a parent as Manager. Every senior team must have a parent/player as Manager.

TRAINING:

Coaches will organise the training day, time and venue for your team. As you can appreciate, it is impossible to please every player in regard to training days with all the activities in which our children participate. Please remember that the coaches are giving up their free time for your child so please be flexible in this matter.

UMPIRES:

All Seaforth players from 12 years and over must umpire rostered games. Players 12 years and older are encouraged to sit for the Umpires Exam (available online at www.netball.asn.au and click on umpire exam link). Once umpires have achieved a Pass (70%), they are not required to resit the exam for six years.

It is imperative a parent is present at each game to support our 12 and 13 year olds. Should a player fail to do their umpiring duty, penalties will be incurred by Manly Warringah Netball Association which the player or team are expected to fulfill.
